Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 1.57 tCO2e by 2029. This is a reduction of 20%

The quoted five-year reduction will be achieved using GHG offsets. The figure is, in any case, extremely low.

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

This is CambridgeCultura's first year of carbon reporting, as such there are no completed initiatives.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- We recognise that the nature of our business (SIC: 70229 - Management consultancy activities other than financial management) means that our Scope 1 emissions are negligible. We aspire to keep Scope 1 emissions at, or near, nil.
- We recognise that our operating structure, with extensive online consultation, and shared office space results in favourable Scope 2 and 3 figures. We hope to continue similar operating practices.


This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
